



Trends for 2013?

- Less resources / better weather

- Confessional and political aspects (acceptance by host population, Palestinian refugees, etc)
- What shelter solutions?
 - Helping refugees where they are Vs creating housing units?
 - Target few most vulnerable Vs aim at significant coverage?



Damascus and surroundings = over 5M persons, 30km from the border

- → Contingency :
 - Preparedness through coordination,
 mappings, scaling up response capacity
 - Identification (and preparation?) of "transition sites" and collective centres
 - Stockpiling of shelter materials and NFI for Lebanon and Syria
