Background

Despite the hundreds of shelter projects completed around the world every year after conflicts and natural disasters, there are few compilations of case studies and best practices. As a result, opportunities to consolidate lessons learned are often lost.

"**Shelter projects 2015-2016**" will be a compilation of case studies of the past few years of emergency shelter responses in support of natural disaster and conflict affected populations.
