#### Background

Despite the hundreds of shelter projects completed around the world every year after conflicts and natural disasters, there are few compilations of case studies and best practices. As a result, opportunities to consolidate lessons learned are often lost.

**"Shelter projects 2015-2016"** will be a compilation of case studies of the past few years of emergency shelter responses in support of natural disaster and conflict affected populations. It will contain case studies of significant projects implemented by governments, UN agencies, international organisations and NGOs.

"Shelter Projects 2015-2016" will focus on projects which maximize the use of emergency response funds by paving the way for sustainable recovery. It will be available to the humanitarian community **free of charge** and will build on the previous editions, which can be downloaded from:

#### Audience

The document will be aimed at **both non-specialists** and specialists so that they can learn from past experiences. Specifically the document will be targeted at:

- $\checkmark$  Programme managers and field shelter programme staff from both national and international organisations.
- ✓ Government officials.
- $\checkmark\,$  People who manage shelter programmes as well as those who may do so in the future.

#### Criteria for inclusion:

The case studies will be selected using the following criteria as a guide:

- ✓ The shelter project is now complete.
- ✓ The project must have been **implemented on a large scale**. Trials or design concepts will not be included.
- ✓ The majority of the project must be implemented within the first year following natural disaster. For conflictaffected populations, chronic emergencies and returns processes, longer timescales will be considered.
- ✓ Accurate project information is available from staff involved in the project implementation.
- √ The case studies will be selected to illustrate a diversity
  of approaches to meet shelter need. Providing shelter is
  more than simply designing architecturally impressive
  structures.

#### How can you help?

We are currently looking for **new case studies** of emergency, transitional shelter, reconstruction and recovery projects for inclusion in "Shelter Projects 2015-2016". We are particularly interested in projects implemented between 2015 and 2016.

We are also interested in **comments and updates** on previously reported projects.

Additionally, we would like to include **opinion pieces** on current relevant topics in the shelter and settlements arena.
