But also...

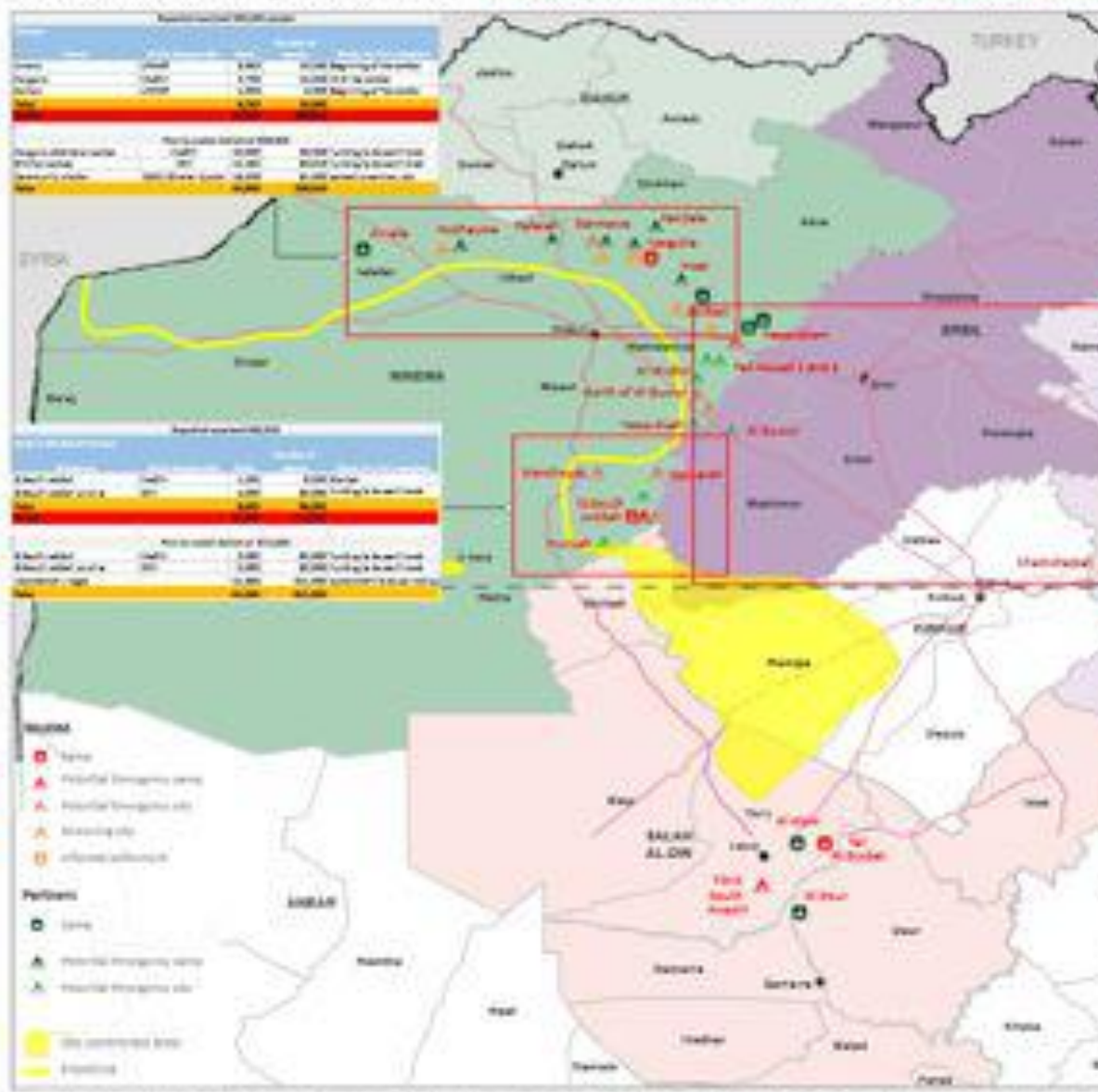
- Has to be at Scale and on Time?

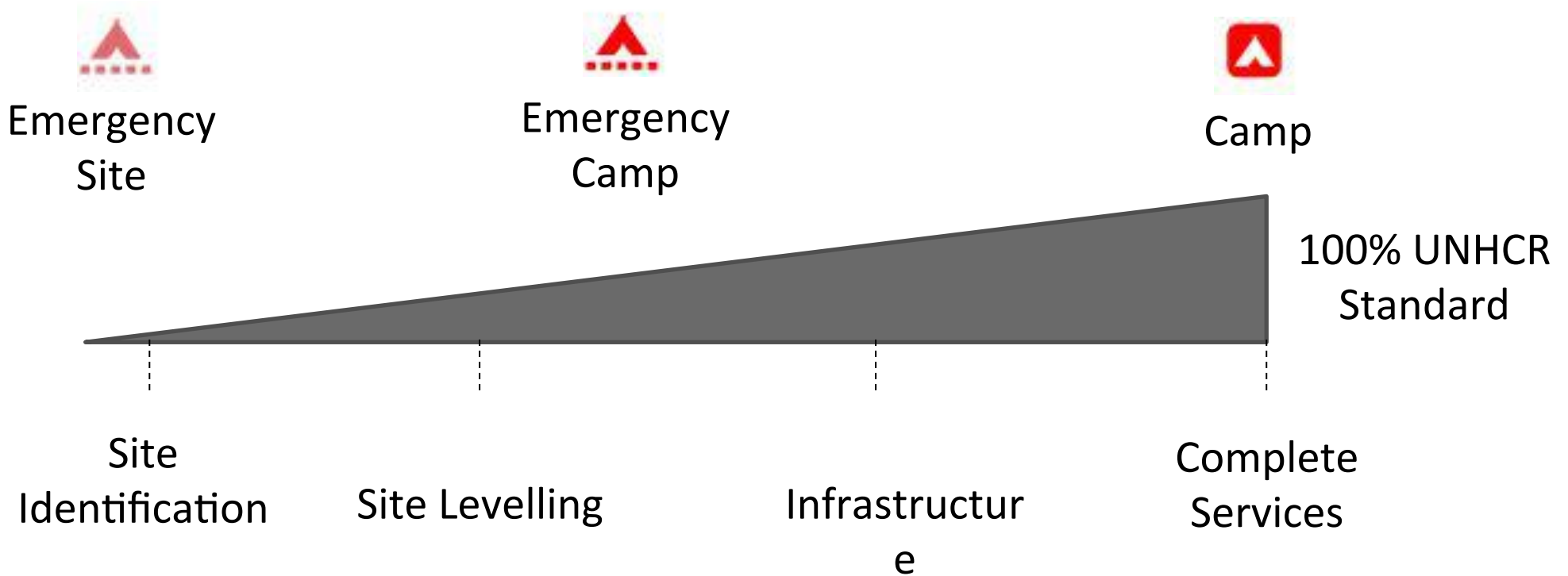

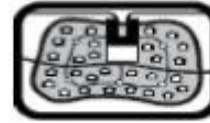

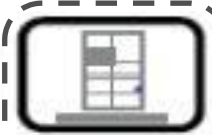

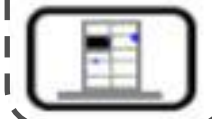

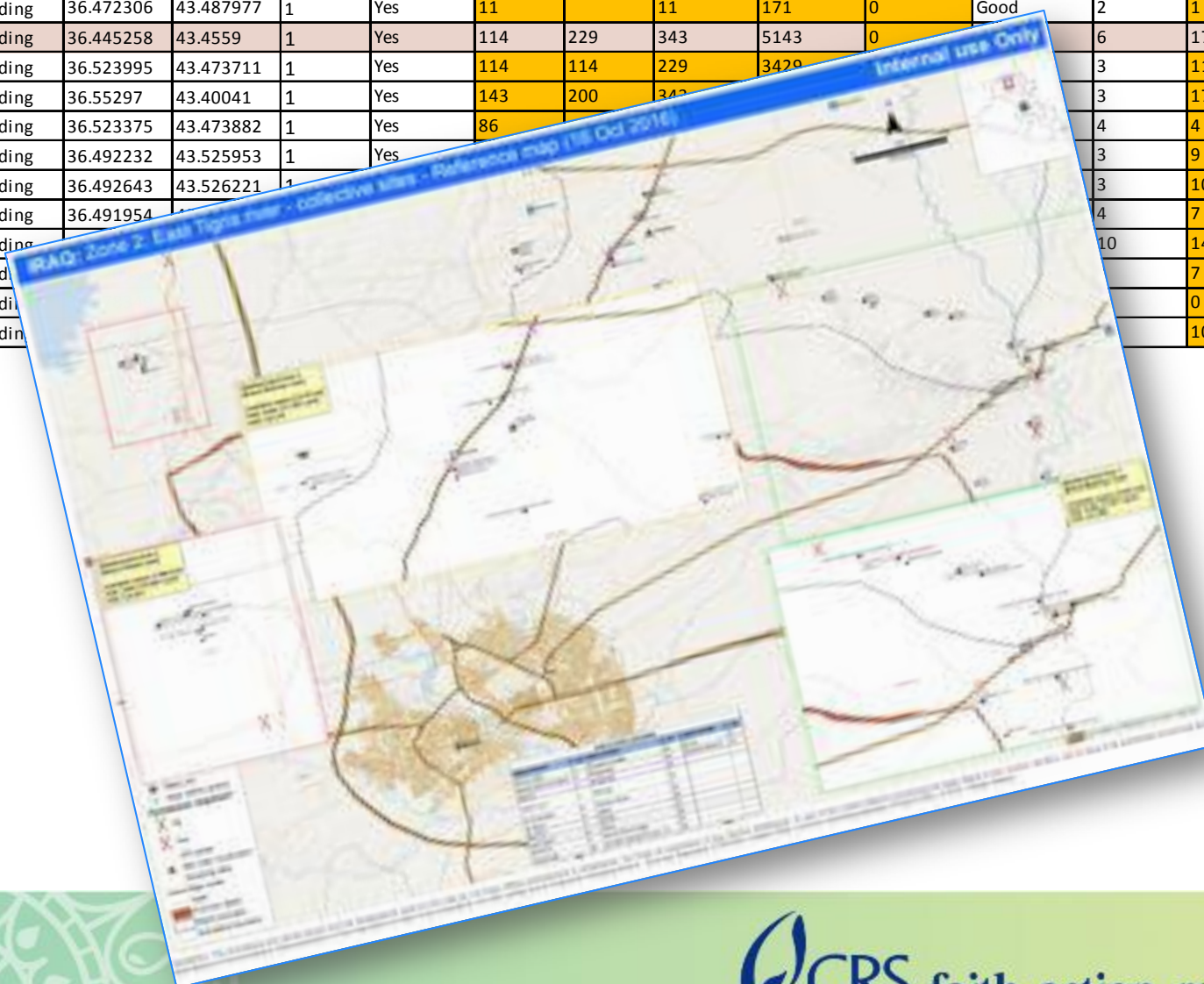

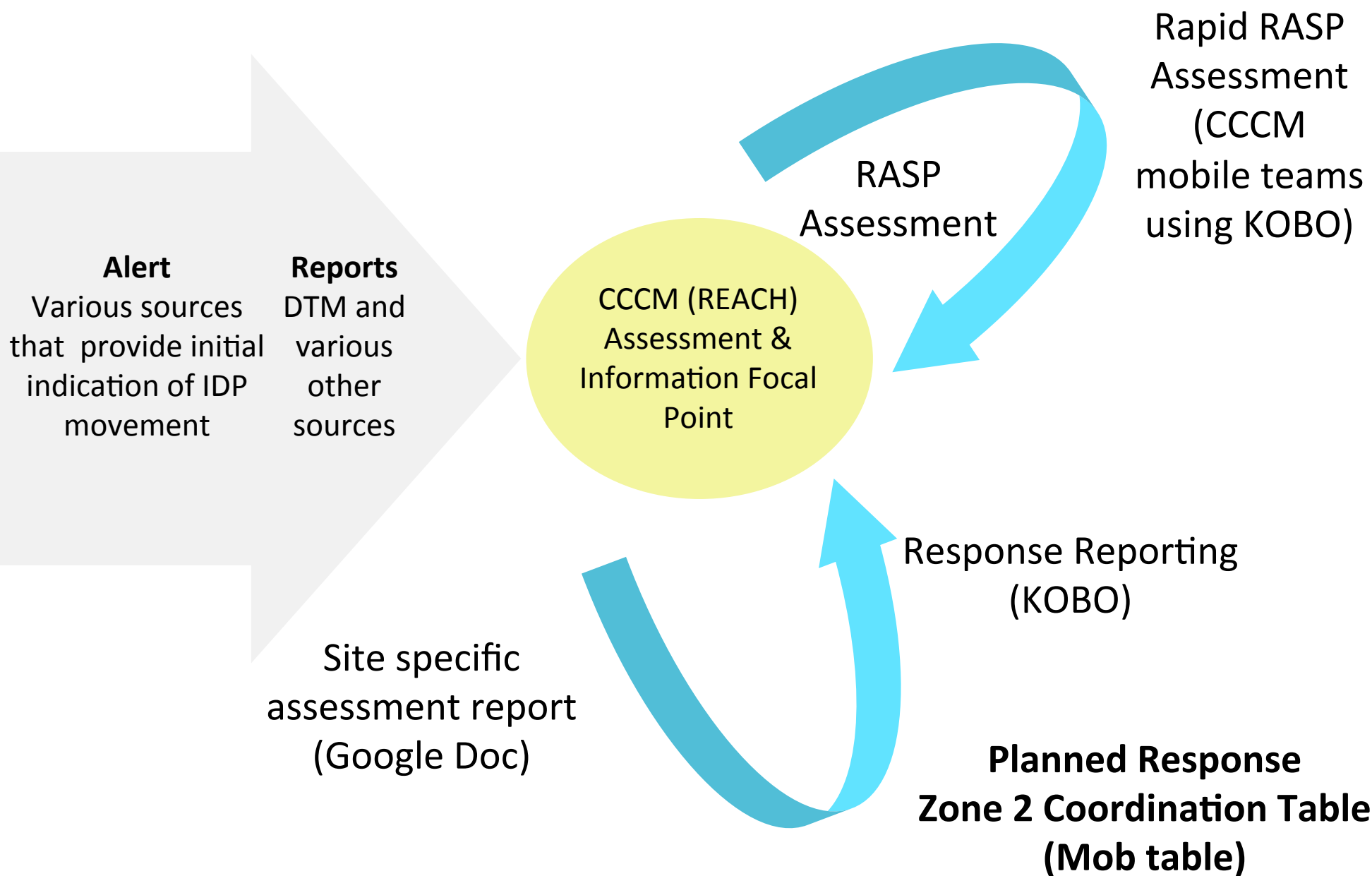
- Identified the location and capacity of partners

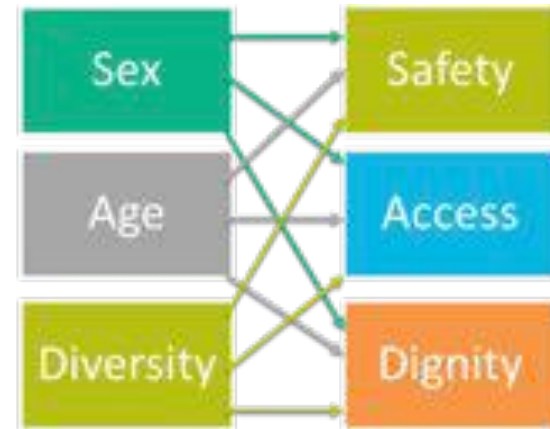
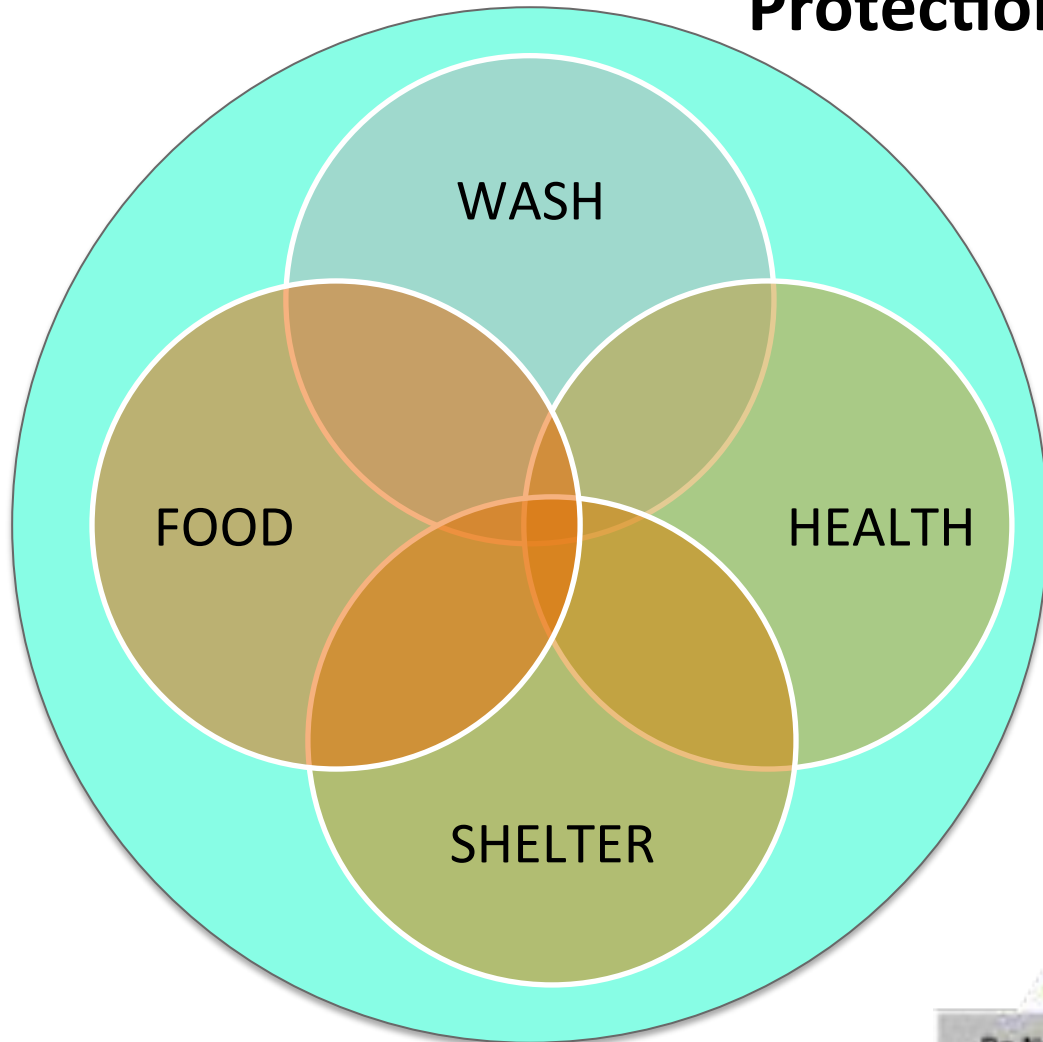

Conclusions...

- Good coordination can look like integration, but is not quite the same
- Integration is **Community Up** rather than **Cluster Down**...which already exists in good programming
- Integration in emergencies does not have to be complicated and Clusters can facilitate and coordinate this

Recommendations...

- Local operational mechanisms and requirements to define coordination and reporting systems...not the other way round.
- Cluster coordinators share the same work space
- Engagement with local NGO and local government essential for an integrated approach
